### RELEASE FROM LIABILITY WAIVER

SAFETY NOTICE: Archery is a very safe sport if range rules are followed. The range rules are listed below and are posted on the range. Range rules are also reviewed routinely and always with new students. Please read the attached range rules and sign below that you understand them and agree with them for yourself and/or your minor child or any party with you.

I am voluntarily participating in activities related to Archers Artemis and I release, waive and discharge Archers Artemis for myself, my spouse, children, guests or any parties connected with me from any and all liability from any incident that may occur at any event related to Archers Artemis. I am aware that we may be doing some outdoor shooting. I agree to be aware of my surroundings at all times. I agree to wear sturdy, closed toed shoes or sneakers. In our temporary facility at 10 Industrial Way, we were told that there is a marijuana growing facility on the grounds but we have a permit from the Town of Amesbury Building Inspector who has followed up on all the laws related to this.

All sanctioned archery instructors and coaches at Archers Artemis are certified by USA Archery. We are not liable for any archery advice given by anyone at Archers Artemis other than those certified by USA Archery. Please check with Coach Ricci about sanctioned instructors and coaches.

PERMISSION TO TOUCH: In order to demonstrate or to show you how to accomplish the proper bow arm position, stance, back tension, etc., sometimes the instructor may need to touch your head, neck, shoulders, arms, hands, back, trunk, hips, legs and feet to help you get into the proper position. And with a job well done, sometimes a spontaneous hug could happen! At Archers Artemis we always ask the student directly if they are comfortable with this. In keeping with Safe Sport Guidelines, two adults need to be present when a child is at the range. Please check to make sure another adult other than the instructor is present before you drop off your minor child. A parent or legal guardian or authorized adult must be present for the beginning of the first session.

## RANGE SAFETY RULES

PLEASE OBEY ALL THE RULES LISTED HERE AND ANY RULES GIVEN BY THE STAFF OF ARCHERS ARTEMIS

- Walk on the range at all times. No running allowed.
- If you hear four or more whistles or the command **STOP**, let the bow down, remove the arrow and place it in your quiver.
- The only direction a bow with an arrow loaded can be pointed is down range.
- Stay behind the safety line at all times unless the command to walk to the shooting line is given (Verbal command or **2 whistles**.)
- Arrows are to remain in quivers at all times except after the command is given to shoot when ready (verbal command or **1 whistle**).
- When you have finished shooting, step behind the safety line.
- Do not step over the shooting line until the **CLEAR** command is given (verbal command or **3 whistles**.)
- When retrieving arrows, stand to the side of the target. Place one hand on the target and place the other hand near the base of the arrow. Prior to pulling, check behind you to make sure no one is near the arrow. Place each arrow in your quiver one at a time once you have pulled it out of the target.
- If you drop an arrow on the shooting line you may pick it up **only** if you do not have to move your feet to do so. If it is beyond that reach leave it there until the end.
- Never release the bow string unless there is an arrow on it. This is called a dry release and it can cause serious harm to both you and the bow.
- No alcohol or non-prescription drugs are allowed on the premises.
- If you are under the influence of non-medically prescribed substances you will be asked to leave.
